

Application for Appointment to the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee

The Citizens Bond Oversight Committee is established as an advisory committee to the Superintendent. The Committee shall be composed of at least 10 at-large community members and up to two students. The purpose of the Committee is to convene quarterly, or as needed, to review progress on the projects detailed in Oregon City School District Bond Measure 3-545. The Committee will review program progress and monitor program spending and schedules. The Committee will report quarterly to the Superintendent regarding program progress.

The Committee will have its initial meeting not later than December 17, 2018, and will be dissolved on December 1, 2022, or upon issuance of a final report by the Committee after all projects authorized by Oregon City School District Bond Measure 3-545 have been completed, whichever is earlier. Meetings shall be held at a time and location to be determined by the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee. Applications are due no later than 4:00 p.m. on October 26, 2018.

Eligibility for the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee:

- 1. Live within the Oregon City School District
- 2. Be a registered voter* (*students not required to be registered)
- 3. Not be an officer or employee of the District
